

A challenge (usually difficult-to-read text) that quizzes us to see if we are human or an automated bot on the web spreading spam. It can also come in the form of an audio challenge or a puzzle to be solved. <u>CAPTSCHA</u> = Completely automated Public Turing test to Tell Computers and **Humans** apart


Trackback?



Trackback

When another blog is linking to a specific post on your blog, and your blog shows that reference so that comments both on and off the blog are consolidated with their respective blog posts. Trackbacks are sometimes generated automatically; sometimes the blog software requires a special link to be added to create the relationship between blog posts. Also known as a linkback or pingback





Link love?



Link love

Linking to someone's blog or website when you mention that person in a blog post.

This helps boost that person in search engine rankings



Linkbait?



Linkbait

Linking to someone's blog specifically for the purpose of having that person link back to the blog post. This is often done in the form of a long list of links to various blogs in an attempt to drive significant traffic to the blog post and drive the blog up in search engine ranking. Many bloggers consider this on par with spam.

Permalink?

Contraction of the words "permanent" and "link" (URL).

A URL that links directly to an individual blog post. This is useful for directing readers to specific blog posts because over time those blog posts will role off the blog's front page.




Link rot / linkrot?



Link rot / linkrot

Link rot (or linkrot) is an informal term for the process by which, either on individual websites or the Internet in general, increasing numbers of links point to web pages, servers or other resources that have become permanently unavailable. The phrase also describes the effects of failing to update out-of-date web pages that clutter search engine results. A link that doesn't work anymore is called a broken link, dead link or dangling link. - Wikipedia

It is common for blogs to feature advertisements either to financially benefit the blogger or to promote the blogger's favourite causes.




