
Dear Sir,

I have been instructed by the Working Committee of the African National Congress to advise you that, it has been decided that you should represent the National Action Committee of the African National Congress and the South African Indian Congress at the Fact Finding Commission of the United Nations Organisation enquiring into the question of racial discrimination in South Africa.

The Committee is not aware of the exact date of your return to South Africa; and, should this be before the sitting of the Commission, we would request you to postpone your return until after you have given your evidence.
