COLONIAL SECRETARY'S MINISTERIAL DIVISION.

Report of the Council of the University of the Cape of Good Hope for the Half-Year ending 30th June, 1904.

Presented to both Houses of Parliament by Command of His Excellency the Governor

1. In accordance with the request of the Legislature that the financial year shall terminate in future on June 30th, the Council has the honour to present to His Excellency the Governor the following Interim Report of its proceedings during the half-year ending June 30th, 1904.

2. There has been no change in the Constitution of the Council during the half-year.

3. Leave of absence for various periods was granted to Sir Bisset Berry, Dr. Gregory, and Mr. Advocate Searle.

4. At a meeting of Convocation held in March, Professor W. Ritchie, M.A., was elected President of Convocation for a period of two years, in place of Rev. Professor Walker, M.A., LL.D., who retired by effluxion of time.

5. During the half-year the following persons were admitted to the examinations specified.

6. Important changes have been introduced into the Geometry syllabus of the School and Matriculation Examinations.

7. The Council is pleased to report that arrangements have been completed for conducting the Law Examinations of Natal in a way similar to that adopted in the case of the corresponding examinations of the Transvaal and Orange River Colony.

8. For the Examination in the Theory of Land-Surveying of 1906, revised Regulations have been framed, and in that year a Preliminary Examination of Matriculation standard will be compulsory.

9. For the Intermediate and B.A. Examinations revised syllabuses in Botany, Zoology and Biology have been drawn up.

10. The Music (written) Examinations were held at the following 50 Centres:—Alice, Aliwal North, Beaufort West, Bedford, Bethlehem, Bloemfontein, Burghersdorp, Cala, Cape Town, Cathcart, Cradock, Durban, Durban Road, East London, George, Graaff-Reinet, Grahamstown, Johannesburg, Kimberley, King William's Town, Kleinpoort, Klerksdorp, Mafeking, Malmesbury, Middelburg (Tr.), Molteno, Mossel Bay, Newcastle, Oudtshoorn, Paarl, Pietermaritzburg, Porterville, Pretoria, Prince Albert, Queenstown, Rawsonville, Riversdale, Robertson, Rondebosch, Sidbury, Smithfield, Somerset East, Somerset West, Stellenbosch, Swellendam, Uitenhage, Vryburg, Wellington, Worcester, Wynberg.

11. The Council is pleased to report that considerable progress has been made with the scheme for the erection of the proposed University Buildings. Mr. W. Hawke, the architect, visited Cape Town, and made considerable improvements in the designs which will enable the Council to call for tenders at the end of 1904.

12. Appended are the usual financial statements, showing the receipts and expenditure for the half-year, and the position of each of the funds administered by the University.
