TO MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF FORT HARE

Advocate Cloete informs me that he is still of opinion that the Council cannot properly use the funds of the College for the payment of pension benefits to resigning members of staff.

He is equally clear (opinion attached) that a cash equivalent for long leave earned before the end of 1959 can be paid to resigned members of staff and that no undertaking should be required of them with regard to new employment.

I suggest that these opinions be reported to Council with a recommendation from the Executive that pay in lieu of long leave be granted.
