Dear Professor Matthews,

Thank you very much for your letter of the past year. Thank you for the recommendations you wrote for me.

I am sorry to be a bother, Sir, and be forced to ask you to kindly write me another one on the enclosed sheet which must be sent to Pretoria. I have just received them today Sir. I have been asked to fill them and send them immediately. The closing date is 15 March 1960. I know you are busy trying to settle down after such a change. I have been asked to ask my Professor to recommend me Sir. You have been kind to me and I sincerely hope you will be kind again.

We sons you have taught are trying hard to make your name known here or all over Africa. I was in Maseru and saw Rakella who did Administration with me. He is a Chairman of the Civil Service and has been chosen to go abroad to see the Secretary of State. I am a delegate from Swaziland to see the Secretary of State and request him to equalise pay without discrimination based on colour.

Fort Hare has done good to this continent and it's still to do more.

I would like to go abroad to do

M. A. in Administration i.e. Native Administration or African Studies. I would like to finish that and return to Swaziland and try and help in the formation of a good government of this country. My line of specialisation in the U.S.A. would be African Studies — in the line of Administration of African countries. After having study and acquired principles of research I would like to present a Thesis on <sup>one</sup> African States.

I will be most pleased if you can help me once more Sir. I hope we shall succeed at last. If I get such a degree many channels open here. I can take the Secretariate work. I can also be employed by Government as a Labour officer. I can also be a Staff member of the Local Govt and Companies.

As I told last time Sir I am in charge of a school with 450 pupils. I have 12 teachers under me. I will have one graduate in April. We have 2 form I's and one form II and III. It's quite a big school. It has a primary section too. The school also need ~~more~~ <sup>highly</sup> qualified teachers. It needs M. A. or people with more experience.
