Let me hear from you in due course. My wife joins me in kindest regards to Mr. Matthews & yourself,

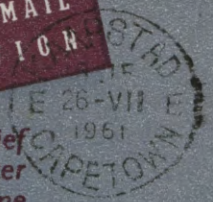
