I herewith beg to apply for the post of Vice-Principal
of Mysore College which I gather your Council is about to consider.
I trust that my application will arrive in time for it to
be included among those to be considered.

As far as my qualifications are concerned, I hold the degrees of B.A. and LL.B. of the University of South Africa and the M.A. degree of Yale University in the United States. I also hold a professional teaching certificate - the College Education Diploma of The University College of Fort Hare.

As regards my teaching experience this has been
from 1925 to 1957. From 1925 to 1935 I was Headmaster
of the High School Department of Adams College in Natal.
From 1936 to 1959 I was on the staff of the University
College of Fort Hare as Head of the Department of African
Studies. On several occasions I acted as Principal
of Fort Hare, thus gaining experience of the administrative
side of the College. I resigned my post when Fort
Hare was taken over by the Union Government, although
I had not yet reached retirement age. I will be 59
at my next birthday on October 20, 1960, but I am
still in a good state of health. I would be available after January 1961.
I am Tswana-speaking and although
in the Union all my life, being a Bilingual I have been
interested in the affairs of Bechuanaland Protectorate

in general and of Uveng College in particular.
