On behalf of the Council and Senate of the University College of Fort Here I a setting as Acting Principal to express to you, the Ramangwato Tribe and the family of the late Mr. Tshekedi Khama, our deepest sympathy in the sad loss which you have suffered as a result of his untimely death.

Tshekedi Khama was a student of this College and both while he was here and after he left, the College was proud of the reputation which he established for himself and for his people.

For many years he rendered devoted and distinguished service to the Bamangwato Tribe in particular, and to the people of Bechuanaland in general. We have no doubt that his record will inspire many young Africans to endeavour to follow in his footsteps in working for the betterment of the conditions of their people and for promoting a deeper understanding between the different peoples represented in this sub-continent.

It will no doubt be difficult to replace a man of such distinguished gifts as Tshekedi Khama possessed, but you and others who were associated with him in his efforts will continue the work to which his life was devoted.
