1. To review and consider theological submissions (to be requested by Dr. Blake from six theologians).
 2. To review and consider:
 - (a) a report of the C.C.I.A. Executive,
 - (b) a report of the Chairman and Director based on replies to their questionnaire to Commissioners, and
 - (c) critical comments by three members not involved in C.C.I.A.
 3. To re-examine the international situation, existing and emerging, and to identify the areas of main ecumenical concern so that the W.C.C. can continue to make its proper contribution to peace, justice and freedom.
 4. To consider the future role of C.C.I.A. in relation to this contribution (see 3 above).
 5. To consider the future administration and structure of C.C.I.A. under the following headings:
 - (a) Aims
 - (b) Functions
 - (c) Ethos and Methods of Work
 - (d) Deployment of Resources
 - (e) Organisation of the Commission
 - (f) Relationships
