Dear Professor,

I should like to thank you for your letter of the 17th February. I will, of course, treat the contents of your letter as strictly confidential.

I feel very much concerned about the treatment which has been meted out to the former members of the Fort Hare Staff under section (3) 1(resignations) of the Transfer Act. I am sending you a copy of Hansard which contains a copy of a reply to a question I have asked in the House of Assembly. It seems to me that the Department have confused the Provident Fund and the Pension Fund.

I intend to raise this subject in the Budget debate. It is a financial matter and the earliest opportunity for discussion will be the debate on the motion to go into Committee of Supply. I am anxious to have the facts and any assistance you and your former colleagues can give me will be valuable.
