Dear Mr Moore,

I found your note awaiting me on my return from Pretoria yesterday, have passed it on to Professor Burrows who is writing to you & commenting on the Minister's figures. I am not in a position to do so, but think there is something incorrect in that all the officers received Provident Fund sums but only

those dismissed received the capital value of their pension - which may be what he calls "Gratuity." It may be that the two columns have been interchanged & checking with those figures I gave you in the House. This seems probable.

Incidentally the figures I gave you were as supplied to me by the Fort Hare authorities for communication to the Minister so they should be reasonably good approximations to the actual figures. I leave it to Burrows to send his detailed comments with kind regards. Yours sincerely, T. Acton
