a difficult one but I was wondering if
you would be kind enough to see what you
can do about him. Rev Calata has been released
and as they have always worked together and
had the same principles of co-operation between
the races in our country I am hoping my
husband will also soon be released. I think
the Church may have been behind his release,
but cannot be sure.

very great and will be so happy if something
