# Desktop Assistive Technology for Visually Impaired Students and Staff

### > The Dolphin Pen



Instead of installing access software on a computer, the Dolphin Pen allows users to plug the Pen (with the software) into the USB drive of any workstation, and is used with earphones.



## Desktop Assistive Technology for Visually Impaired Students and Staff

➤ Merlin: The Merlin is a desktop electronic magnifier that helps clients with low vision to read for extended periods of time. It is available at the Information Desk on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the Unisa Library, Muckleneuk Campus, Pretoria.
