KEY CONCEPTS

Volunteer A person who offers his or her service, or who is recruited

to render a service at a welfare agency, usually without

remuneration.

Home based Care The provision of health services by formal or informal

caregivers in the patient's home in order to promote, restore

and maintain a person's maximum level of comfort, function and health including care towards a dignified

death.

Palliative Care Care for those patients whose needs are primarily for

comfort and relief, as medical cure is not possible. It

acknowledges death while focusing on life.

Participatory Research Entails a group of people planning together what they are

going to research and how they are going to find out something new about the issue that is important to them.

'Step Down' facility

Non-hospital based continuum of care facility for the HIV

positive patient. It encourages family intervention and

support.

Motivations Motivations can be defined as a concept used to describe

the factors within an individual which arouse, maintain

and channel behaviour towards a goal.

Expectations Expectations can be defined as what is considered the most

likely to happen. An expectation may or may not be

realistic but is a wish nonetheless.

Continuum of care Addresses care related issues from the time of infection to

death and to the psychosocial and economic impact on the

survivours.
