Dear Sirs,

When I left South Africa last year in August, my travelling arrangements were handled by your agents in Durban, Natal, South Africa, who gave me such satisfaction that now that I am making arrangements for my return trip, I have decided to ask you again to be my agents in this matter.

I am not at present quite sure as to the date when I shall leave New York, but I think that May 26 is as likely as any date just now. So I want you to book me provisionally on the Cunard Liner "Berengaria" leaving for Southampton on that date. I hope to leave England on the 22nd of June by the "Arundel" Castle arriving at Cape Town, July 9th. From Cape Town I want to go to Durban overland via Kimberley.

With regard to the Class of travelling, I want to go by the Tourist from New York to Southampton and by Third from Southampton to Cape Town, and Second by rail from Cape Town to Durban via Kimberley.

I would like you to let me know roughly what the cost of the trip will be, and whether I shall be entitled to the usual rebate for through bookings on the Cunard-Union Castle lines. Kindly send me all other information which you know I ought to have. I want it to be understood, of course, that my plans at present are subject to alteration, and I shall take the first opportunity of letting you know about any change in my plans.
