Description

The Library subscribes to 300 main titles of electronic databases and the number is growing. Each of these titles has a unique URL and contains many more individual titles. The Digital Commercial Collection Developer is responsible for the administrative duties related to these databases and the Millennium (OASIS) Electronic Resource Management module is used for this purpose. The Library subscribes not only to new titles but information related to the existing electronic databases changes and needs to be updated at an ongoing basis.

Current & future

- The workgroup is now at:
 - Testing the display and style sheets feedback & changes
 - More rigorous testing of creating the database
 - Creating of On- and off-campus screens
 - Finalization of "Trial resources" screens
- In Phase 2 (2012), attention to:
 - Adding URL's to mobile access
 - Passworded resources
 - Ranking of e-resources within subject lists
 - Wish list:
 - adding PL name & contact detail to Subject page
 - Information on accessibility complaincy



Using e-resources on your mobile



Mobile access for <u>licensed</u> e-resources

- Mobile = smart phones (Apple, BB, Android, Windows)
- Tablets & E-book readers?
- Licensed e-resources:
 - Access is required via Unisa authentication & IP address
- Two publisher or vendor dependent options:
 - Access via <u>mobile friendly</u> web pages; and/or
 - Application based access, or access via an app
- Limited search options but includes full text
- URL's will be listed on new Library mobi site
- Instructions on a new library web page



ScienceDirect & Scopus

- Application based access
- Access via the SciVerse App ScienceDirect & Scopus
- Download from the SciVerse web site
- Personal registration on the web pre-requirement
- Use the personal registration details to install the app
- Need to re-install the app after 9 months
- Search functionality:
 - Basic searching
 - Viewing full text
 - E-mailing articles
 - View alerts





- View full text pdf's and e-mail articles












EBSCO - Basic search screen
