Description

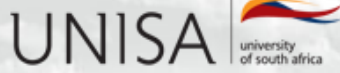

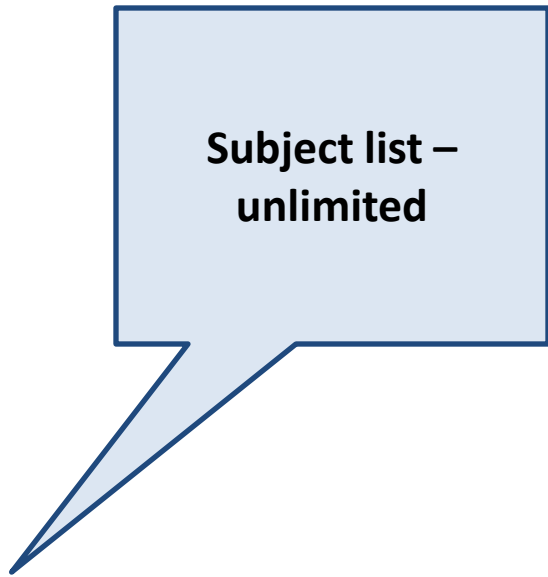

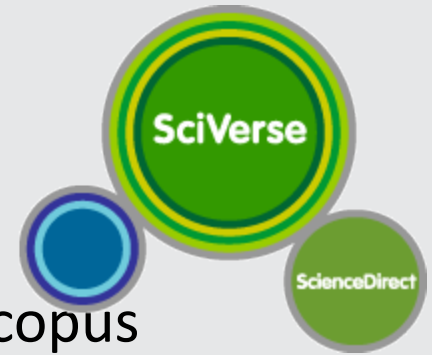

 - Application based access, or access via an app
- Limited search options but includes full text
- URL's will be listed on new Library mobi site
- Instructions on a new library web page

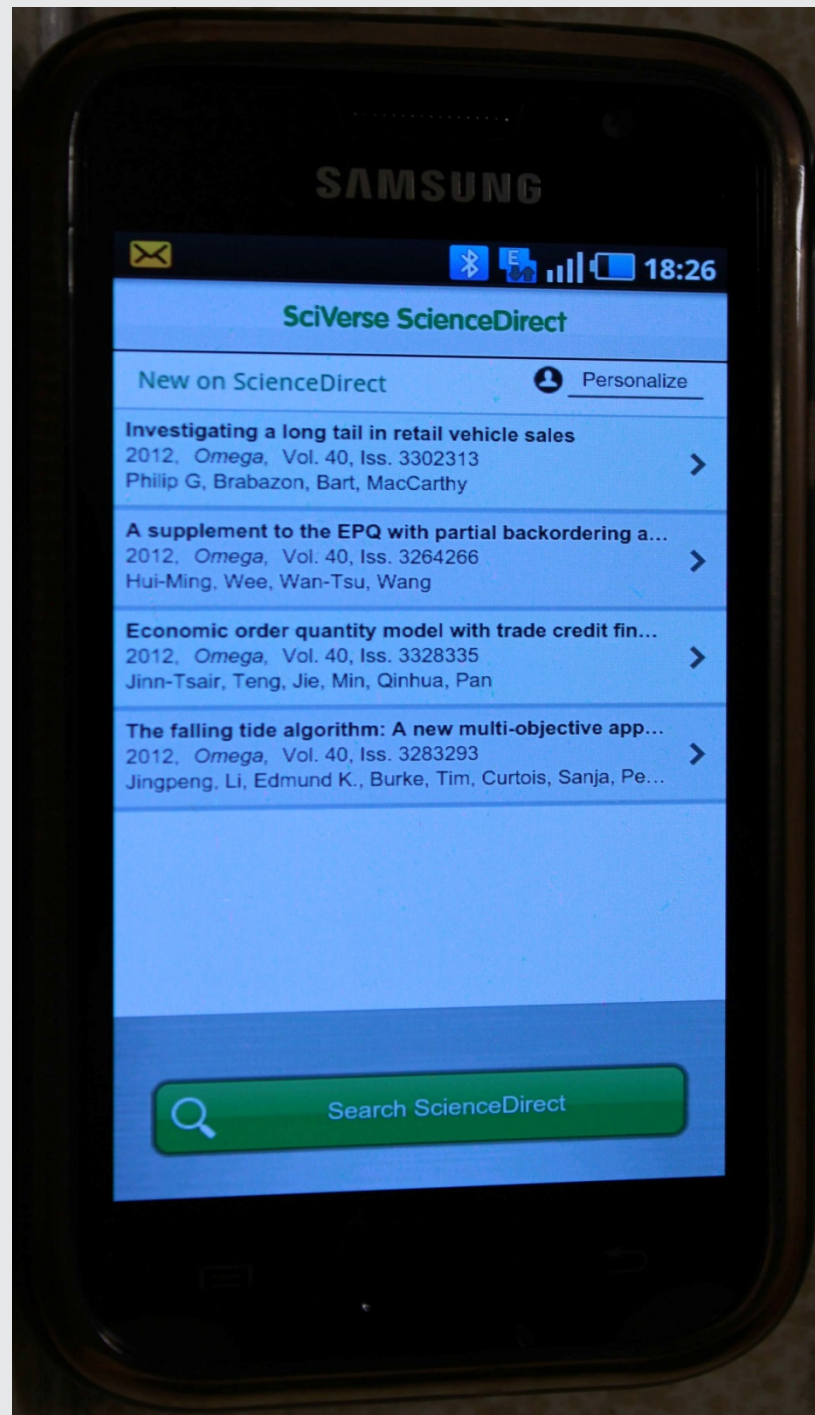

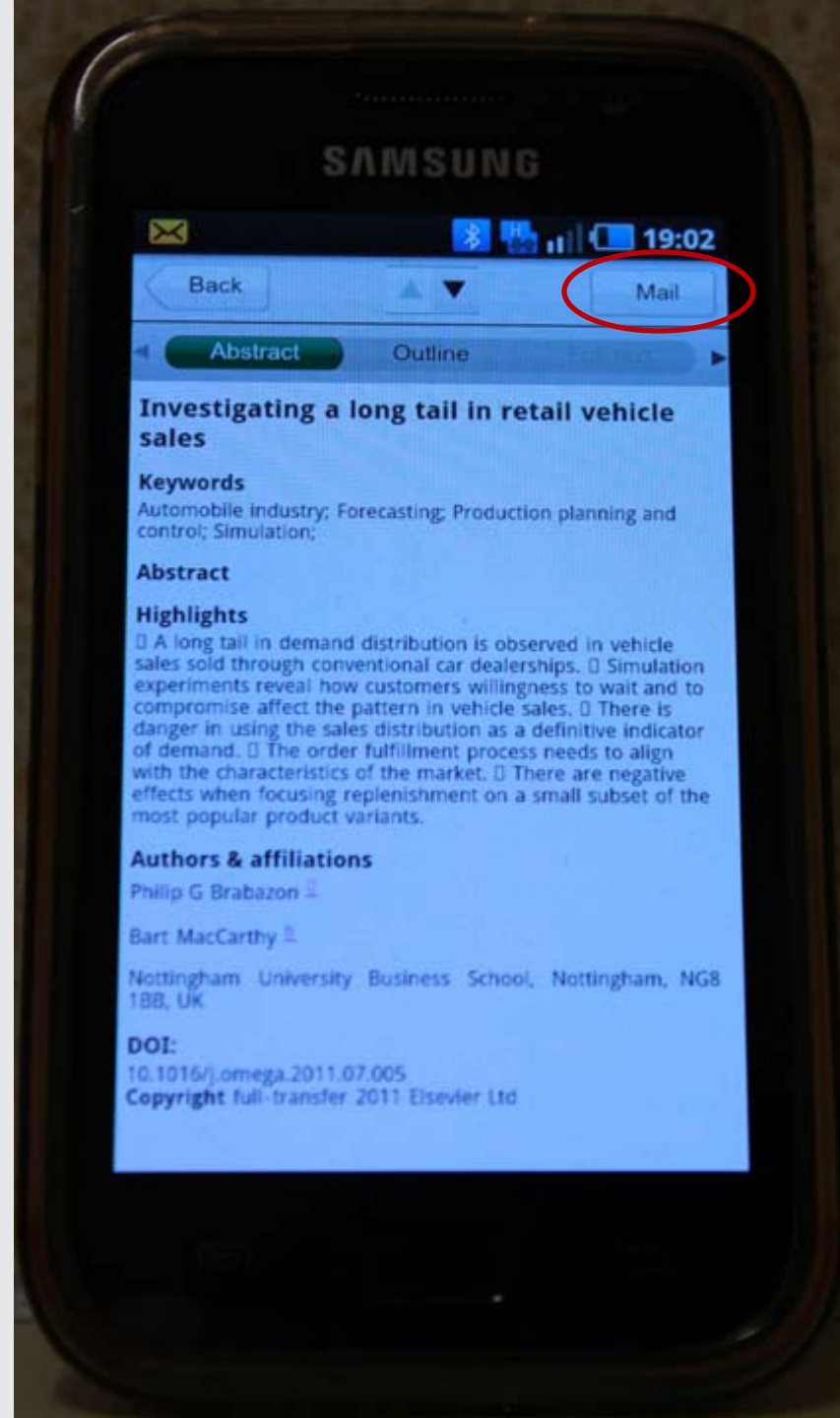
