Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter RW/PCP dated 3rd November, 1959 in which you refer to my recent decision to resign my post at Fort Hare and the consequences of that decision.

At the outset I want to thank you for your interest in my welfare and the welfare of my children. I should like to convey to Doctors Edgar Brookes and Alan Taylor our deepest appreciation of their concern and their wish to make a contribution to the practical difficulties with which we are now confronted.

With regard to the question of a permanent address I should like to point out that I shall not be leaving Fort Hare before the end of the year, so that until then my address will continue to be P.O. Fort Hare. It is not yet certain what the position will be after that, but as I have my home here in the town of Alice, the Fort Hare address will do until I advise you otherwise. I take it that the best thing will be for you to send me the Forms to which you refer now so that I should be able to deal with them.
