Dear Mr Kossew,

Thank you for your letter of 30th October, 1959 in which you refer to my decision to resign my post at Fort Hare with effect as from December 31, 1959. I notice that you refer also to the possibility of my leaving South Africa. That is, of course, pure speculation on the part of the Press. The question of what I am going to do when I leave Fort Hare is at the moment is an open question, and I shall naturally give very careful consideration to any offers of alternative employment which I may receive.

I want to thank you very much indeed for thinking about me at this difficult time and suggesting the possibility of my joining the staff of African Horizon. I agree with you that there is a great deal of this "non-collecting business" to which you refer in the Eastern Province. Without committing myself on the Company at the present time I think I can say that I would give careful consideration to any proposition which you care to make in this regard. At any rate we have got a certain amount of time to consider the matter as I shall not be free from Fort Hare before December 31, 1959.
