If you have not been able to get the pass-port for this man, send me two snaps of him (pass-port size) together with a letter from the Principal of Fort Hare which is his present home. The letter must deal with the character of the man in addition to giving information about his educational attainments. On receipt of these I shall see what I can do to help.
