Dear Sir,

This is to let you know that I received the circulars which were sent over here in connection with the "Grad Ball" to be held in Grahamstown on 22nd April, 1961. I have taken steps to see that they are distributed at Fort Hare and elsewhere.

I should like to inform you, however, that my attention has been drawn to the fact that arrangements are being made for a "Grad Ball" to be held at Fort Hare on the same evening.
