

OPINION FROM MR. J.D. CLOETE, Q.C.

Arising out of the opinion which I gave to Consultant on the 18th November, 1959, I have been asked to consider whether, if members of staff are paid monetary benefits in lieu of long leave on the basis advised in my opinion, they would be precluded by law from immediately obtaining employment elsewhere.

It is quite clear that there would be no such restriction upon such staff members who would be quite free to enter upon any employment of their choice elsewhere.
