Vacation Course, Fort Hare, 2 - 6 July

TRAINS arrive at Alice station, about 1 mile from Fort Hare, at 8.15 a.m. from Cookhouse and at 6.15 p.m. from King William's Town.

Upon arriving at Fort Hare, members of the course "book in" at Stewart Hall, receive their identity cards, and go to their Hostel.

FEES amount to 25/-; if Non-European members board at Fort Hare, this 25/- pays for board and lodging; for Non-European members who board elsewhere the fee is 12/6. Attendance for 1 day (no board) costs 5/-.

For European members there are 2 hotels and a **boarding** house, with charges of 15/-, 12/6 and a day respectively. If members wish, Fort Hare will book accommodation on their behalf as soon as they have paid their Course fee; otherwise members may write direct to The Royal Hotel, or Amatola Hotel, or Mrs H. A. Sumner, Alice.

TRAIN FARES: Under certain conditions Conference concessions are available to members of the course; cost: excursion fare + 20% + 15% tax. Members should secure a T 117 Concession form, fill it in correctly, and send it to SANC Educ, Fort Hare; SANC Educ will then make every effort to obtain a concession. As all this will take time please send your T 117 at once.

Please book your return journey at your own station. The course will be conducted in English. Members who will board at Fort Hare are required to bring sheets and blankets

THE COURSE programme is provisionally given overleaf - changes will probably be made, and if so, members will be duly informed. Every effort will be made to provide a thoroughly practical course not only in the lectures but also by showing actual lessons and demonstrations, by films and exhibits of charts and school equipment, by showing "how to....", by discussions, by leaflets, etc.
