1:00 p.m. Dinner at college with a few students and Mr. Cornish,
who is Director of Religious Activities.

5:00 p.m. Westminster F.O.R. - Dr. Robert Powell
Informal meeting with Westminster F.O.R. at supper.
This is a small group in a small town. The group though
small is active and has had some difficulty in the town
because of their stand on race relations. *They would want to
hear about current situation in South Africa.*
